Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to Section 9 of the October 9, 2020 settlement agreement on permanent rates approved by Order No. 26,433 on December 15, 2020 in Docket No. DE 19-057 (the "Settlement"), Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") is required to submit a filing no later than March 1 of each year regarding its Regulatory Reconciliation Adjustment ("RRA"): (1) containing reports on its reliability statistics and vegetation management activities; and (2) requesting that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") open a new docket to consider the filing and the Company's annual RRA rate change. Thereafter, on or by May 1, the Company is required to update its RRA filing with information pertaining to all other components of the RRA filing, along with supporting testimony and exhibits for rates effective August 1 of that year.

On March 1, 2022, the Company submitted a petition along with the testimony and supporting attachments of Robert D. Allen, Jennifer J. Hebsch, and Russel D. Johnson, providing the relevant information and explanations of the Company's vegetation management activities and reliability performance in calendar year 2021. The Company now provides the materials and support for the remaining segments of the RRA as contemplated by Section 9 of the Settlement.

Enclosed is the testimony and supporting attachments of Marisa B. Paruta and Edward A. Davis providing the relevant information supporting the proposed change to the RRA for effect August 1, 2022. Mr. Davis is also proving individual testimony and supporting attachments regarding calculation of lost base revenue due to net metering, which is included in the overall RRA calculation. Consistent with the petition submitted on March 1, 2022, Eversource requests that the Commission include the enclosed information in its review in this proceeding. The Company also respectfully requests that a hearing in this matter be scheduled for no later than June 30, 2022 to allow sufficient time for implementation of the proposed RRA rate change.
