
Dear Chairman Goldner:

On August 31, 2022, I wrote the Commission to inform it and the parties about the status of Condition No. 11 in the Memorandum of Understanding (the “Memorandum”) between the Town of Londonderry (“Londonderry”) and Bodwell Waste Services Corporation.¹ In that letter, which has been marked as Exhibit 11 to the final hearing in this matter, I explained that the Londonderry Town Council would consider approval of the transaction contemplated in the Memorandum on September 12, 2022.
