Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 26,687 issued on September 15, 2022 approving Bodwell Waste Services Corporation's (Bodwell) termination of sewer service, attached please find the progress report due November 30, 2022.

The attached progress report shows that the construction is ahead of schedule and that the parties are on track to de-energize Bodwell's pump stations on or before December 30, 2022.

Bodwell is pleased with the progress to date. Bodwell notes that in addition to some flow still entering the Rosecliff pump station, Bodwell continues to utilize its gravity mains and sewer services to deliver sewage to the City of Manchester. The transfer of the gravity mains and sewer services to the City of Manchester and Town of Londonderry are expected to take place when the sewer facilities deed of transfer is signed, no later than December 30, 2022.

Regarding customer billing, based on the construction schedule and de-energizing date, Bodwell anticipates issuing final invoices to customers January 2-4, 2023 for 4th quarter sewer service.
