To provide clarification with what has changed on these approved pages, UES hereby resubmits the redline versions of these pages which were previously included in what has been marked as Exhibits 1 and 2. Please note, that aside from the required approval designation listed in the line at the bottom of each of these pages, no other changes have been made compared to what UES included with its initial filing, dated March 25, 2022, in this docket.

In addition to these filed tariff pages, changes to UES's Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts for effect June 1, 2022 are also necessary, as the revisions to tariff page 74 affect the discount levels. Changes to the Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts, however, are currently pending in DE 21-030 for effect April 1, 2022, and in DE 20-092 and DE 19-043 for effect May 1, 2022. After compliance filings are made for the April 1 and May 1 rates, UES will file revisions to the Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts for effect June 1, 2022 in this docket.
