Dear Clerk:

On October 12, 2022, in the above referenced docket, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES" or the "Company") made its compliance tariff filing in accordance with NHPUC Order No. 26,694 for rates effective December 1, 2022. In the cover letter to that filing, as well in testimony accompanying UES's initial filing on September 23, 2022, the Company noted that a further change to UES's Summary Of Whole House Residential Time Of Use Rates And Electric Vehicle Rates, Page 5-A would need to take effect January 1, 2023 to incorporate the January through July 2023 G1 class Renewable Portfolio Standard ("RPS") Charge approved in DE 22-017 (Order No. 26,694). UES stated that it would file Page 5-A no later than 30 days prior to January 1, 2023.

On December 1, 2022, UES will file its System Benefits Charge ("SBC") proposed for effect January 1, 2023 in a separate docket. UES plans to include Page 5-A as part of the compliance tariff filing in that docket, which will incorporate the SBC and the RPS Charge.
