Enclosed please find the petition of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) for its competitively procured default Energy Service (“ES”) rate proposed to begin August 1, 2022. Consistent with the settlement agreement in Docket No. DE 17-113, Eversource has procured ES for customers in its large and small customer groups for the period of August 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023. The fixed ES rate for the period of August 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023 for the small customer class is \$0.22566 per kWh. This represents a 111.5% increase in rates over the current period of \$0.10669 per kWh. For the large customer class, the proposed monthly rates are presented below next to the monthly rates from the current period.


