

Dear Chairman Goldner:

On September 16, 2022, the Department of Energy (“DOE”) filed its recommended disallowances from the Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy’s (the “Company”) Third Step Adjustment. After further review, and in the interest of maximizing the possibility that the issues can be resolved efficiently in a single hearing, the Company has proposed to remove recovery of these costs from the third step adjustment under review in this proceeding, and defer recovery of the costs associated with the Nashua Work Center Renovation and Millyard Substation Replacement projects until its next rate-case proceeding. The Company is authorized to represent that it has conferred with DOE and that DOE stipulates to this deferral. DOE and the Company agree that the costs associated with these projects would be eligible for recovery following a prudence review as part of its next base-rate proceeding.¹
