On October 3, 2022 the Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource" or the "Company") filed a letter advising that the Company and Department of Energy ("DOE") continued to engage in settlement discussions, in the above-referenced docket. The Company's letter also requested that the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") schedule a second day of hearings at which the parties would either (a) present a settlement agreement; or (b) the Company would conduct cross-examination of the DOE's witness. On October 6, 2022, the Commission issued a Procedural Order setting October 17, 2022 as the second hearing date and directing the Company to file a final status update regarding settlement by close of business on October 7, 2022.
