Please accept the following report on behalf of the parties present at the technical session, held following the prehearing conference on September 7, 2022, in the above-referenced matter. All parties to this docket were in attendance at the technical session, which includes the following: Pennichuck Water Works, Inc.; the Office of the Consumer Advocate; and the Department of Energy (DOE) (collectively the Parties).

While the Parties engaged in meaningful discussion at yesterday's technical session, which included the topic of submitting a proposed procedural schedule to the Public Utilities Commission for approval, the Parties agreed it would be more prudent to withhold submission of a finalized proposed procedural schedule until the Parties meet again in technical session on September 22, 2022. The Parties anticipate that a proposed procedural schedule will be finalized and submitted for Commission approval no later than September 26, 2022.

The Parties agreed, furthermore, that discovery would proceed in the interim. At this time, the DOE intends to propound discovery today, September 8, 2022.
