Dear Chairman Goldner:

On September 30, 2022, the Commission approved the parties’ proposed procedural schedule that included multiple rounds of discovery. The Department of Energy (DOE) has issued its second set of data requests and Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) has requested additional time, beyond the November 30, 2022 due date, to assemble the information needed to respond to the data requests. As a result, both the DOE and PWW request that the Commission approve the following modifications to the procedural schedule:

Data Requests (Set 3)	<del>January 4</del> <b><u>January 11</u></b> , 2023
Data Responses (Set 3)	<del>January 18</del> <b><u>January 25</u></b> , 2023

The DOE and PWW do not propose any further changes at this time to the remainder of the approved procedural schedule. PWW reached out to the Office of the Consumer Advocate for a position on this revision, but PWW had not yet heard back as of the date of this filing.
