Letter Request to Change Start Time of Technical Session

Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Commission's temporary filing requirements dated March 17, 2020, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. and the Department of Energy request that the start time for the technical session approved for February 1, 2023 be moved from 9 AM to 1 PM.

Since the approval of the technical session, the Commission has set a hearing in another matter on that date that is important for the Department to attend. Therefore, the Department has requested that the start time be delayed. Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. is amenable to that change. The Company contacted the Office of the Consumer Advocate, however, it has not yet heard, as of the filing of this letter, from the Consumer Advocate on whether delaying the start time presents a conflict. There are no other parties to this proceeding.
