Chair Goldner:

By Order No. 24,750 (May 25, 2007) in Docket No. DE 06-028, the Commission approved the use of a Transmission Cost Adjustment Mechanism ("TCAM") rate by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource" or the "Company") for the recovery and reconciliation of costs related to transmission-related services. Consistent with how the TCAM is adjusted following Docket No. DE 18-089, the TCAM rate is to be adjusted on August 1 at the same time as adjustments are made to Eversource's Energy Service and Stranded Cost Recovery Charge rates.

By this letter, Eversource hereby requests that the Commission open a docket for Eversource's 2022 adjustment to its TCAM rate. In the near future, Eversource will submit its TCAM filing in a manner consistent with past practice. The Company would also like to note at this time, that the necessary witnesses will be unavailable starting July 15 through the end of the month, so Eversource respectfully requests that a hearing in this matter be scheduled prior to July 15, 2022 so that the 2022 TCAM rate may take effect on August 1, 2022.
