
Chair Goldner:

Enclosed for filing, please find the petition, exhibits, and pre-filed testimony in support of a financing transaction requested by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("PSNH" or the "Company"). This routine financing transaction would include the issuance of up to \$600 million aggregate principal amount of long-term debt securities through December 31, 2023 and the mortgaging of utility property.
