I, Jessica Chiavara, counsel for Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy, hereby certify the following:

On October 11, 2022, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission issued an Order *nisi* No. 26,700 Docket No. DE 22-051. In part that Order required that “Eversource shall post its new tariff provisions on its website within 10 calendar days of this order for the benefit of new and existing customers who may request starting, terminating, or transferring service, to be documented by affidavit filed with this office on or before November 7, 2022.” Order at 3.

On October 21, 2022, an updated tariff including the new tariff provisions was posted on the Eversource website. A screenshot of the page with the identification verification policy is attached to verify that the new provisions were published on October 21, 2022.



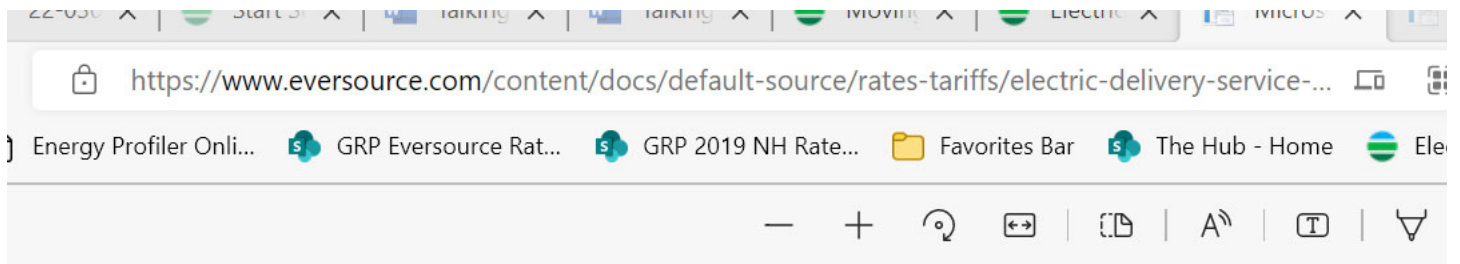

Method of Application

The Company may accept an oral application by a prospective Customer for residence service. In the event that an oral application for service is received by the Company from an applicant not currently a Customer, for a location where service is scheduled to be discontinued for non-payment or is currently disconnected for non-payment, the Company may request application be made in writing as a precondition for service. Prospective customers must satisfy the Verification of Identity requirements described below as a precondition of service. The Company reserves the right to refuse service, at any location, to an applicant who is ineligible to the Company for any service furnished to such applicant, consistent with the statute of limitations. However, the Company shall commence service if the applicant has agreed to a reasonable payment plan.

Verification of Identity

The Company reserves the right to verify the identity of any prospective Customer to ensure the accuracy of the information provided as a precondition for commencing service. Valid identification entails one of the following: Social Security Number; Driver's License or License Number; a Valid Passport Issued by United States or a Foreign Government; State ID Card; Green Cards (Alien Card); Birth Certificate; Military ID; ID used by federal, state or municipal government.
