RE: <u>Northern Utilities, Inc., Docket No. DG 22-059, Proposed Cost of Gas</u> <u>Adjustment for the Winter Period (November 2022 – April 2023) and</u> <u>Summer Period (May 2023 – October 2023) – Corrected Compliance Tariff</u> <u>Pages</u>

Chairman Goldner,

On October 27, 2022, the Commission issued Order No. 26,713 approving Northern Utilities, Inc.'s Cost of Gas rates for the 2022-2023 winter period and for the 2023 summer period. Consistent with the Order, Northern filed compliance tariff pages on November 2, 2022. The Commission issued a Letter of Compliance on November 9, 2022, confirming that the Company's tariff filing complied with Puc 1603 filing requirements.

After receiving the Commission's compliance letter on November 9, 2022, two inadvertent errors in the tariff were brought to the Company's attention. First, the Company's Maximum Winter Residential Cost of Gas Rate on Revised Page 42 was shown as \$1.4112; Order No. 26,713 shows the rate to be \$1.4111. The Company now encloses a revised compliance tariff page, Twelfth Revised Page 42, showing a rate that is consistent with Order No. 26,713.

Enclosed also please find Northern Utilities, Inc.'s revised compliance tariff page, Sixteenth Revised Page 86, that replaces the version submitted in the November 2, 2022 compliance filing. The version submitted on November 2, 2022 inadvertently omitted language describing the residential heating low income discount. The revised tariff page, filed in compliance with NHPUC Order No. 26,713 in the above referenced proceeding, more clearly identifies the discount to low-income residential heating customers during the winter season.
