Hello,

I am writing as a concerned NH resident with regard to Net Metering for small solar energy systems in the state. It's come to my attention that there is significant concern that the PUC commissioners may not accept the settlement agreement that has been established by the state's utilities, consumer advocate, and other stakeholders. Given that the State's one study showed no unreasonable cost increases in electricity due to small-scale solar energy adoption, it seems very reasonable to me to keep net metering the same for the next couple of years as the settlement recommends. The PUC is appointed to represent the public, and the public supports renewable energy and Net Metering. Please accept the settlement agreement to keep net metering in NH.
