I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

I urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement. This is important to me because having my own solar panels is an important part of keeping my costs down as a retired person on a fixed income. I was able to take advantage of state and federal tax credits and rebates while I was still working so that now I can stay in my own home as I get older. **It has made a BIG difference because I basically don't have to pay a monthly electric bill.**
