Governor Sununu,

I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

***I urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement.***

We recently had a contractor visit our house since my wife and I “were” planning to invest in solar energy to stabilize and offset our electricity costs. We can’t do that without net metering. I have another contractor that I talked to but we have delayed them visiting until we are sure net metering will continue.
