Subject: Support for CPCNH Proposal in Net Metering Docket (PUC Docket DE 22-060)

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We recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission will soon issue an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. We understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by several parties in addition to other proposals offered by the Community Power Coalition and the NH Department of Energy.

We urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement with the proposed modifications by the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire allowing solar energy producing customers to participate in their Community Power programs. We installed solar on our roof 5 years ago and have been contributing our excess energy to our utility and to the REC requirements of our utility, Liberty. We have received credit for the excess power we produce. However, we have been prevented from joining Hanover Community Power because it has not been allowed. So we contribute to our utility, but continue to have to pay the slightly higher prices for electricity and buy power that is not as clean because our utility has prevented us from joining HCP. This has been very frustrating. What about taking care of all customers and allowing freedom of choice?? Other utility customers may choose from whom they get their electricity and at what price.

We are copying the PUC Clerk, Jared Chicoine, and Christopher Ellms on this email so that our concern and support for the Settlement Agreement will be entered into the docket as a public comment.
