I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

I urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement. I am a member of my town's energy committee and we are charged with guiding the town, both the municipality and residents, to the energy goals approved in our 2021 Town Meeting of converting to 100% renewable sources of energy by 2050. Net metering is an important piece of achieving this goal.
