Subject: Concerned about the future of net metering in NH (PUC Docket DE 22-060)

I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

I urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement. I am in the process of installing a 20 kW ground mount array and rely on net metering to make this a viable financial and environmental venture. It would be a shame if net metering went away and all the jobs which are centered on materials and installation were negatively impacted.

I am copying the PUC Clerk on this email so that my concern and support for the Settlement Agreement will be entered into the docket.
