Chairman Goldner:

In response to the Commission's request in Order No. 27,085 that the utilities provide timeframes needed to respond to each of the Commission information requests issued on November 25, 2024, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("Unitil" or the "Company") provides the following information.

Unitil has worked diligently to prepare responses to the Commission's requests and now believes that it will be able to provide responses to all but one of the requests by December 20, 2024. The Company will not be able to provide a response to request #2 by December 20 due to the significant volume of information requested and the availability of personnel to collect, review, validate, and format the information. Unitil therefore requests an additional four (4) weeks from the December 20, 2024 deadline to respond to request #2.

Unitil will file as many responses jointly with the other electric utilities as possible, and those responses will be filed with all others except for question 2 by December 20.
