Consideration of Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure**

Dear Chairman Goldner:

In Order No. 27,074 (Nov. 18, 2024), the Commission approved the Joint Utilities' proposal for interconnection fees, effective January 1, 2025, and approved the collection of those fees through an appropriate mechanism that reconciled the fees collected against the incremental administrative costs incurred, as presented in Attachment C to the Settlement Agreement, marked as Exhibit 1. The order stated that "Liberty shall file notice to the Commission of which existing rate mechanism it intends to file for its annual reconciliation of the interconnection fees within five days of this order." Order No. 27,074 at 33.

On November 22, 2024, the Company requested to delay the application of the interconnection fees and implementation of the associated reconciling mechanism due to changes in circumstances, to be revisited when Liberty expects to incur incremental administrative expenses. On December 17, 2024, the Commission issued Order No. 27,088, denying the Liberty's request to delay application of the fees and directing Liberty "file notice to the Commission of which reconciling mechanism it intends to use for the reconciliation of application fees ...." *Id* at 3.

The Company has chosen to use the Stranded Cost Recovery Charge for the reconciliation of the fees and administrative costs. The Stranded Cost Recovery Charge reconciliation is included in the Company's Annual Retail Rates filing in late March. Attached to this letter is the Company's compliance tariff filing which includes both the applicable fees and language implementing the reconciling mechanism, which is in accordance with the parameters laid out in Attachment C to Exhibit 1.
