On June 21, 2023 the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") issued a procedural order with two record requests, asking that "the New Hampshire Department of Energy, Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (Liberty), Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource), and Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES) . . . collaborate and provide a coordinated response . . . on or before the close of business on July 12, 2023."
