PETITION FOR INTERVENTION
IBEW local 490

Pursuant to the Order of Notice issued on September 20, 2022 by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) in the above-captioned docket, N.H. Admin. Rules Puc 203.17, and in accordance with the standards of RSA 541-A:32, IBEW local 490 (“local 490”) hereby petitions for leave to intervene in this proceeding. In support of its Petition, local 490 states the following:

1. IBEW local 490 is a statewide employer of hundreds of professionals currently working in the renewable energy field. Our professionals service New Hampshire’s residential, commercial, and municipal markets for green and renewable energy options. Our mission is to provide working professionals to the green energy movement, and to help foster the state of New Hampshire into a healthy diverse energy portfolio through clean, efficient, renewable energy.

2. IBEW local 490 has received support from its hundreds of members, and wide range of electrical contractors currently working in the state. The body of local 490 members is comprised of primarily New Hampshire residents, with a vested interest in New Hampshire’s energy future.

3. This workforce will play a critical role in the evolution of New Hampshire’s energy system as electrification of end uses in the building and transportation sectors accelerates, and as distributed renewable energy generation and battery electric storage projects are deployed at all scales across the state. This docket will consider issues that determine the pace of that

transformation and the growth of this workforce.

4. Local 490 has a strong interest in enabling all citizens, local governments, businesses, and manufacturers to use on-site and distributed renewable energy; net metering is an important policy tool to enable the deployment of such projects.


