Dear Chair Goldner,

Attached please find the Swanze Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan for a review and approval by the Commission pursuant to RSA 53-E:7.

This Plan was developed by the Swanze Community Power Committee and adopted by unanimous vote of the Town Meeting, its legislative body, on March 9, 2022. The plan was then amended in October 2022 to better address questions of data security as well as updates to align with the PUC 2200 rules for Community Power. This amended Plan is being submitted prior to approval by the Board of Selectmen, which is the Town of Swanze's governing body.
