
Chair Goldner:

Pursuant to New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 203.06 and 203.11, please find the attached petition for authorization of a regulatory asset for costs associated with implementation of the Puc 2200 rules, and petition for a waiver of Puc 2203.02(b)(5), for filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) on behalf of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”).

These petitions were originally filed as motions to Docket No. DRM 21-142, but the Commission denied them without prejudice in Order No. 26,707 as inappropriate for consideration in a rulemaking docket, and directed Eversource to refile the same substance in the form of a petition. These petitions are pursuant to that direction and request the same relief as the motions that preceded them.
