On March 17, 2023, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc., Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy, and Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (the "NH EDCs") submitted a Joint Motion for a one-week extension of time to file Initial Comments in the above-referenced docket. The NH EDCs demonstrated good cause for the requested extension, explaining that personnel who are integral to development of the Initial Comments were engaged in response to Winter Storm Sage. As of this writing, the Commission has not ruled on the Joint Motion.
