CPCNH Revised EDI Working Group Process Recommendations

In Order No. 26,903 issued on 11/15/23 in this docket the Commission both ordered the docket closed and requested comments from parties on the process for an EDI working group going forward to be filed in this docket on or before 12/15/23. The Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire's timely filed such comments found at tab 74 of the docket book.

Today I am submitting for filing in this closed docket a revised version of our 12/15/23 filing. The only things that have changed are the table and its footnotes on pages 6-7, along with formatting changes to accommodate the larger table and longer footnotes.
