Re: DE 22-081 Electric and Gas Utilities – 2023 Adjustments to the Energy Efficiency Portion of System Benefits Charges

Dear Chairman Goldner:

This letter is to inform the Commission that New Hampshire Electric Cooperative ("NHEC") has posted Order No. 26, 745 and new System Benefits Charge tariff page on NHEC's website.

Order No. 26, 745 requires that "the Joint Utilities post their respective new tariff provisions and a copy of this order nisi on their respective websites no later than December 16, 2022," and to document such posting by affidavit filed with the Commission on or before December 20, 2022. Because page 1 of the Order does not include NHEC in the definition of "Joint Utilities", NHEC assumes that it is not subject to the Order's posting and affidavit requirements. Nonetheless, NHEC has voluntarily posted the Order and tariff pages, and is filing this letter as a courtesy to the Commission.
