Dear Chairman Goldner:

The Commission issued a procedural order on February 21, 2023 moving the prehearing scheduled for February 23, 2023 to March 3, 2023 due to the forecasted inclement weather. Unfortunately, the undersigned counsel has a conflict with that date and is out of the country. It would be cumbersome to have counsel attend virtually while the remaining parties, and especially the undersigned’s clients, are in-person. A hybrid prehearing would stifle any attorney-client communication that may be required at the prehearing.
