## Dear Chairman Goldner:

In Order No. 26,901, the Commission authorized the Colonial Drive Sewer Association and Agape Community Church to transfer the sewer assets located in the Colonial Drive subdivision from Agape Community Church to the Colonial Drive Sewer Association. Attached for the Commission's records is a copy of the fully signed and recorded deed transferring the sewer assets from Agape to the Association. This transfer occurred on December 8, 2023.

Order No. 26,901 exempted the Colonial Drive Sewer Association from Commission regulation and thus, the Colonial Drive Sewer Association deems this filing to be its last order of business before the Commission. The residents of Colonial Drive greatly appreciate the Commission's assistance in bringing this matter to closure.
