RE: Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. Tariff Filing: Light Emitting Diode ("LED"") Outdoor Lighting Service Docket No. DE 22-083

Chairman Goldner:

On November 3, 2022, on behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES" or the "Company"), I filed proposed changes to Schedule LED (renamed to Schedule LED-1) and a new tariff, Schedule LED-2, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement approved, in part, on May 3, 2022 in DE 21-030 (UES' 2021 Rate Case).

After discussions with the Department of Energy, UES has made several revisions and resubmits the following tariffs for effect August 1, 2023:

- Pages 63-C through 63-K, Schedule LED-1
- Pages 63-L through 63-U, Schedule LED-2

The filing also includes a clean and redline version of Page 1 - Table of Contents, Page 28 - Terms and Conditions For Distribution Service, and Page 60 - Schedule OL. Consistent with the initial filing, the redline tariffs of Schedule LED-1 and Schedule LED-2 are provided as Schedules KMA-1 and KMA-2. The changes from the initial filing are as follows:

- Page 1, Table of Contents and Page 28 of the Terms and Conditions For Distribution Service have been revised to include references to Schedule LED-1 and Schedule LED-2.
- Page 60 of Schedule OL, page 63-E of Schedule LED-1, and page 63-O of Schedule LED-2 include corrections to the table for midnight service monthly kWh for three lights. The kWh for three lights were incorrectly listed in the delivery service rate schedules. With these changes, the delivery service rate schedules properly match the Company's rate summary tariff page. The rate summary tariff page is the source page for the Company's billing department.
- Page 63-G of Schedule LED-1 and page 63-Q of Schedule LED-2 have been modified in the last paragraph, Use of Advanced Controls, to clarify that the customer may request

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changes to the average operating wattage outside of the annual anniversary date and made if agreed to by the Company.
