Pursuant to the Commission's temporary filing guidelines dated March 17, 2020 and the approved procedural schedule for this proceeding, attached please find for filing a settlement agreement between Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW), Merrimack Village District (MVD), and the Department of Energy (DOE). The Office of the Consumer Advocate did not participate in this proceeding and there were no intervenors.
