
Chair Goldner:

Please find the attached for review by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), a petition with supporting testimony and attachments requesting approval of a financing, filed by Aquarion Water Company of New Hampshire (“Aquarion” or the “Company”). This routine financing transaction would include the issuance of a general mortgage bond in the aggregate principal amount of up to \$11,000,000 to CoBank, ACB (“CoBank”) to refinance outstanding short-term debt, finance the Company’s capital expenditures, and pay at maturity the Company’s \$3 million 7.71% General Mortgage Bonds, due June 1, 2023.

Aquarion respectfully requests that the Commission open a new docket to approve the financing via order *nisi* in the same manner as the last routine financing of the Company in Docket No. DW 12-098, approved by Order *nisi* No. 25,369, and in the Company’s most recent financing in Docket No. DW 21-072, approved by Order No. 26,490. The Company would request that any order *nisi* issued by the Commission become final and effective on or before April 30, 2023, so that the Company can timely pay the \$3 million maturity due June 1, 2023.
