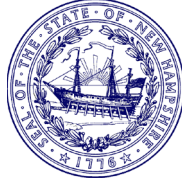

Dear Chairman Goldner:

On December 21, 2023, the Commission issued Order No. 26,920, in which it required Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource or the Company) to file a proposal for an ISO-New England market-based procurement tranche of 10 to 20 percent of the load, through whatever combination of direct Day-Ahead and Real-Time ISO-New England market acquisitions the Company finds advisable, for the Company's upcoming August 2024 - January 2025 energy service period for its Small Customer Group, to be assessed by the Commission in a future phase of this proceeding. Eversource submitted this filing on February 5, 2024.

On February 8, 2024, the Commission issued a Supplemental Order of Notice to assess the proposal and directed the Department of Energy to submit its position regarding Eversource's proposal by March 12, 2024. As such, enclosed please find the Technical Statement of Stephen R. Eckberg regarding the Company's proposal.
