Dear Chairman Goldner:

The order approving default service rates for the period beginning August 1, 2023, in the above docket stated: "on a monthly basis over the six-month default service rate period, Liberty is to file by the 10th day of the following month, a summary comparison of the monthly average ISO-New England market electricity prices with the power supply charge components for Liberty's Small Customer Group." Order No. 26,854 (June 30, 2023).

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp., I write, first, to request a retroactive modification of the due date for the monthly reports referenced above because the information for these reports is not available in time for a filing only 10 days into the following month. The Commission has approved similar requests from Unitil and Eversource. See August 28, 2023, Procedural Order in Docket No. 23-054 (Unitil) and July 27, 2023, procedural order in Docket No. 23-043 (Eversource). Liberty respectfully seeks the same relief, extending the deadline to 30 days after the monthly end.

Second, attached please find a confidential and public version of the Company's report for the month of August 2023. Liberty asserts confidentiality pursuant to Puc 201.06(a)(15). Thank you.
