**Revenue Decoupling Adjustment, Stranded Cost Recovery, and
External Delivery Charge Reconciliation and Rate Filing**

Procedural Order Re: SCC and EDC Filing

On June 1, 2023, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES or the Company) submitted the testimony and schedules of Linda S. McNamara, Senior Regulatory Analyst, regarding the Company's revenue decoupling adjustment factor (RDAF). As this filing did not include a petition or a specific request for relief, *see* N.H. Admin. R., Puc 202.01(a), it appeared to have been made for informational purposes related to the other rate changes UES intended to propose for effect on August 1, 2023, namely, those resulting from changes to its stranded cost charge (SCC) and external delivery charge (EDC).

UES's annual SCC and EDC filing, which was submitted on June 16, 2023, was accompanied by a petition requesting the Commission's approval of all proposed August 1, 2023 rates, including those relating to the RDAF. Therefore, this filing shall be included in the above-captioned docket, which shall be re-titled as "Revenue Decoupling Adjustment, Stranded Cost Recovery, and External Delivery Charge Reconciliation and Rate Filing."
