Chairman Goldner:

On February 27, 2024, the Commission issued a procedural order granting an extension of the suspension of the procedural schedule in this docket until today, March 22, while the parties conferred about a potential resolution to the docket. At this time, all parties agree that the docket should continue, and that a new prehearing conference should be held to gain clarity on certain issues. However, the parties likely differ in the reasons for which the prehearing conference is needed, and so multiple parties may be making filings to the Commission regarding next steps.
