## Re: DE 23-068, Electric and Gas Utilities, 2024-2026 Triennial Energy Efficiency Plan Revised Attachments

Dear Chairman Goldner:

On June 30, 2023, Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities; New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc.; Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy; Unitil Energy Systems, Inc.; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp d/b/a Liberty Utilities; and Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern" submitted the 2024-2026 Statewide Energy Efficiency 2024-2026 Triennial Plan (the "Plan") for review and approval by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.

After the Plan was filed, Northern discovered an error in Attachment J1. Attachment J1 includes summary information related to Cost Effectiveness, Benefits, and the Performance Incentive for each year of the term and for the term as a whole. In its initial filing, Northern inadvertently linked the target for annual and lifetime performance within the Performance Incentive tables to planned kWh savings rather than planned natural gas MMBTU savings. Because the planned Performance Incentive is based on a fixed percentage of planned expenditures, which were not impacted by the error, the design level Performance Incentive amount remains unchanged from the initial filing, i.e., \$139,070.

In order to correct the above-described error, and provide clarity for the record, enclosed with this letter is a revised Benefit Cost Model (BC Model\_24-26\_NU Revised 8-11-2023.xls). This revised model should replace the Benefit Cost Model filed by Northern on June 30, 2023, in its entirety, and the corrections to Attachment J1 have been highlighted in yellow.

Also enclosed with this letter is an updated version of the Plan attachment file containing Northern's replacement PDF pages for Attachment J1 with the corrections highlighted in yellow. These revised PDF pages replace Bates Pages 322, 325, 328, and 331 in the initial filing of the Plan's attachment file (23-068-06-30\_NH\_UTILITIES\_ATT-EE-TRIENNAIL-PLAN.PDF).
