Revised Record Request Responses

Dear Chairman Goldner:

In the process of responding to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's (the "Commission") record requests, Unitil Energy Systems Inc. ("Unitil") discovered that it inadvertently included lighting measures in the Energy Star Residential Products Program in its benefit-to-cost (B/C) model. These residential lighting measures have been discontinued and will not be offered as part of the 2024-2026 Plan. As a result, Unitil's actual measure mix for the 2024-2026 Plan will be different than the planned measure mix.

In the interest of providing clarity and further detail on this issue, Unitil has enclosed revised responses to the following record requests issued by the Commission: PUC 1-001-3; PUC 1-002-01; PUC 1-005-2; PUC 2-003-3; PUC 2-003-12; and PUC 3-002-7.
