Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy 2023 Transmission Cost Adjustment Mechanism

Chairman Goldner:

By Order No. 24,750 (May 25, 2007) in Docket No. DE 06-028, the Commission approved the use of a Transmission Cost Adjustment Mechanism ("TCAM") rate by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource" or the "Company") for the recovery and reconciliation of costs related to transmission-related services. On November 28, 2022 the Commission issued Order No. 26,735, which changed the effective date for the TCAM rate change each year from August 1 to October 1, beginning in 2023. Order No. 26,735 also directed Eversource to file its petition to adjust the TCAM rate during the first week of August each year. By this letter, Eversource hereby requests that the Commission open a docket for Eversource's 2023 adjustment to its TCAM rate. Consistent with the new directive, Eversource will submit its TCAM filing during the first week of August.

Order No. 26,735 notes that Eversource requested a hearing for September 7, but the Order does not set the hearing date. Eversource respectfully reiterates its request for a September 7 hearing. If that date cannot be accommodated, the necessary Eversource witnesses have the following availability during the window a hearing would need to take place so that the 2023 TCAM rate may take effect on October 1, 2023: September 5, 8, 11, and 15.
