Statement of Position of Joint Utilities

Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Commission's request included in the Commencement of Adjudicative Proceeding and Notice of Hearing issued on August 25, 2023, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy, Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc., and New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. (collectively, the "Joint Utilities") submit this joint statement of position regarding the Electric Assistance Program ("EAP") budget filings in this proceeding.

The Joint Utilities support the EAP budget filings submitted in this docket, in particular their respective revised utility budgets¹ and the Community Action Program Revised 2023-2024 Electric Assistance Program Budget submitted on August 4, 2023. The Joint Utilities urge the Commission to approve the submitted budgets with a minimum of process and as soon as possible prior to October 1, 2023. The EAP programs provide critical support for the provision of essential electric service to New Hampshire residents with demonstrated need, and the importance of the continued provision of this program without disruption cannot be overstated.

As it is the Joint Utilities' understanding that no party is contesting approval of the submitted budgets, no objections are anticipated to be raised at or before the scheduled hearing. And each of the Joint Utilities plans to have a knowledgeable representative available to address questions regarding its budget filing and this joint statement of position during the September 21st hearing.
