Re: DG 23-076; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Winter 2023-2024 Cost of Gas – January 2024 Monthly Cost of Gas Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,898 (October 31, 2022) in Docket No. DG 23-076, I enclose for filing the Company's (January) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2023-2024 Winter season ending April 30, 2024.

The calculation reflects the estimated December 2023 through April 2024 NYMEX settled forward prices as of December 14, 2023. The resulting projected over-collection of approximately \$5,083,893 is 9.14% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2023-2024 Winter season.

The Company elects to decrease the cost of gas rate effective January 1, 2024. The current and revised cost of gas rates are listed in the table below.
