Re: DG 23-076; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Winter 2023-2024 Cost of Gas – March 2024 Monthly Cost of Gas Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,898 (October 31, 2022) in Docket No. DG 23-076, I enclose for filing the Company's March calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2023-2024 Winter season ending April 30, 2024.

The calculation reflects the estimated February 2024 through April 2024 NYMEX settled forward prices as of February 15, 2024. The resulting projected over collection of approximately (\$4,057,214) is (8.53%) of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2023-2024 Winter season.

The Company elects to decrease the cost of gas rate effective March 1, 2024. The current and revised cost of gas rates are listed in the table below.
