Attached please find the Plaistow Community Power Plan dated October 30, 2023, for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to RSA 53-E:7, which states:

53-E:7 Aggregation Program.

Section II. Every electric aggregation plan and any revision of a plan to include an opt-out default service program shall be submitted to the commission, either before or after being submitted to the governing body to the legislative body for approval, to determine whether the plan conforms to the requirements of this chapter and applicable rules of the commission.


The Plan is being submitted for Commission review and approval following legislative body approval of Community Power at Plaistow's Town Meeting March 9, 2021. The Plan was developed with public input and approved by the Committee on October 4, 2023, and the Board of Selectmen on October 30, 2023. This serves as notice of final Plan approval as required by PUC 2204.01(g).
