I can't believe that Pennichuck is asking for another rate increase. Does this commission ever deny them one?

They're asking for an increase on the monthly customer charge of the 5/8" water meter. From \$22.56 to \$29.02. That's almost a 29% increase. That's outrageous! The meter is read electronically, so how can they justify that increase? It can't be labor.

This 2024 Social Security cost of living increase was only 3.2%. So I don't understand how Pennichuck can ask for such a large increase.
