City of Nashua Response to Order

Dear Chairman Goldner:

On January 9, 2025, the Commission issued an order requesting the City of Nashua to identify its witness and position with the City no later than 1:00 pm on January 13, 2025. This filing is in response to that request.

The City of Nashua is a signatory to the settlement agreement and fully supports the agreement. The City plans to be present at the January 14, 2025 hearing to support the Settling Parties' presentation of that agreement. The City anticipated cross examining the Department of Energy and Pennichuck company witnesses rather than be a witness itself. However, in light of the Commission's order, the City will fully make available the undersigned legal counsel for the City of Nashua to be called as a witness or to make offers of proof. As legal counsel, I have been intimately involved with the City of Nashua Resolutions attached to the settlement agreement as Attachment G and can speak to the City's position as to the settlement.
