Attached please find the Farmington Community Power Plan for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to RSA 53-E:7. The Farmington Community Power Plan was approved by the Farmington Community Power Committee on November 7, 2023, and the Farmington Board of Selectmen on November 13, 2023

The plan is being submitted for Commission review and approval prior to being submitted to the Town's legislative body for approval as allowed under PUC 2204.01(a). Once the plan has been approved (or rejected) by the legislative body, majority vote at Farmington Town Meeting, the Town will notify the Commission, Department of Energy, Office of the Consumer Advocate, and the distribution utilities serving Farmington, Eversource and New Hampshire Electric Coop, of such final plan approval or rejection, as required under PUC 2204.01(g).
