Re: DE 24-013 Request for Approval of Loudon Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan

Dear Chairman Goldner:

New Hampshire Electric Cooperative (“NHEC” or “the Cooperative”) requests clarification on the Approval of Community Power Aggregation Plan and Notification of Commencement of Service for the Loudon Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan.

The Cooperative fully supports the development of Community Power Aggregations (“CPAs”) and believes that they can be a powerful tool for providing “access to competitive markets for supplies of electricity and related services” and for encouraging “voluntary, cost effective and innovative solutions to local needs” as articulated in the statement of purpose in RSA 53-E:1. The Cooperative also strongly supports the ability of our members to access competitive supply options and was an early adopter of retail choice in New Hampshire.

NHEC was not included in the Loudon Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan filed in DE 24-013 on January 17, 2024 and approved by the Commission on March 13, 2024. However, NHEC was included in the Town of Loudon Notification of Commencement of Service filed in DE 24-013 on April 16, 2024.


NHEC serves 5 accounts in the Town of Loudon.

Since NHEC was not identified in the body of the approved Loudon Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan, the Cooperative seeks clarification from the Commission as to if it should provide data pursuant to Puc 2204.02 (Request for Anonymized Customer-Specific Information from Utilities), Puc 2204.03 (Request for Names, Addresses, and Account Numbers of Customers), Puc 2205.05 (New Utility Service Customers), and Puc 2205.13 (Individual

Customer Billing Information). Each data requirement is premised on the utility providing information for an approved community power aggregation plan. In addition, data from Puc 2204.03 and Puc 2205.05 is used to enroll customers/members.
